

Travel Guidelines

All the participants in the International Summer Bible Conference at the Purdue campus (West Lafayette, Indiana, USA) will travel by various means such as cars and airplanes. We pray that everyone travels safely during this time. Some participants will need help, especially those who come from foreign countries other than Canada. Chicago Headquarters has formed a team to support the transportation for foreign delegates. This will include room and board as needed.

In order to serve you better, we need accurate information on your **arrival date, time, and airport, airline, and number**. Many have entered travel information, but not all. Please enter the travel information through the registration web site: <http://www.ubfservice.com>. Please enter the final airport to USA, not the transient airport. This applies to your departure as well.

Before the conference on July 24, 2008, most foreign delegates will arrive through three major airports in USA: O'Hare (ORD), Indianapolis (IND) and John F. Kennedy (JFK). We have prepared a group of people to welcome you at these airports and help you to reach the Purdue campus.

After the conference on Sunday (July 27), some missionaries will stay one more day for the missionary seminar. The rest of them will return to their mission land according to their travel plan. We will honor their plans and support them as needed. Chicago chapter will take care of the foreign delegates who will visit Chicago until they leave for other chapters or return to their mission land. Other chapters will do something similar for those who visit their chapters. The same plan applies to those who will attend missionary seminary. In order to serve you better we need your itinerary if it is more complex than you entered in the web site. Please, share it with us if you have not done so yet. One method is to send an email to one of the transportation team, especially Henry Park..
